Referendum ordered by Petition

Do the people of the state of Missouri want to adopt Senate Bill 19 ("Right-to-Work") as passed by the general assembly in 2017, which prohibits as a condition of employment the forced membership in a labor organization (union) or forced payments of dues in full or pro-rata (fair-share); make any activity which violates employees' rights illegal and ineffective; allow legal remedies for anyone injured as a result of another person violating or threatening to violate employees' rights; and which shall not apply to union agreements entered into before the effective date of Senate Bill 19?

MIAMI BUILDING PROJECT
2018 QUESTION**

Shall the Board of Education of the Miami R-I School District, Missouri, borrow money in the amount of Eight Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand Dollars (\$826,000) for the purpose of providing funds for the acquisition, construction, equipping, and furnishing of an additional gymnasium to accommodate the scheduling of athletic practice sessions and physical education programs; to complete other remodeling and repair improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue bonds for the payment thereof resulting in an estimated increase to the debt service property tax levy of \$0.41 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to increase from \$0.00 to \$0.41 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
